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Executive Summary

Awards

During fiscal year 2022, awards received by Dartmouth College totaled \$207,422,482, a decrease of 7% (includes financial aid and CARES act) over awards received during fiscal year 2021. Arts & Sciences award dollars received decreased by 9% this year decreasing from \$42,737,824 in FY21 to \$39,020,835. Awards in the Geisel School of Medicine totaled \$94,198,234, an increase of 2% from FY21. Thayer School saw an increase of 14% in award dollars granted in FY22. The CARES act was a response to the COVID-19 pandemic, which included \$13 million in award dollars to Dartmouth College in fiscal year 2021. Excluding the CARES act and financial aid, the change in awarded dollars from FY21 to FY22 is relatively flat (~1%).

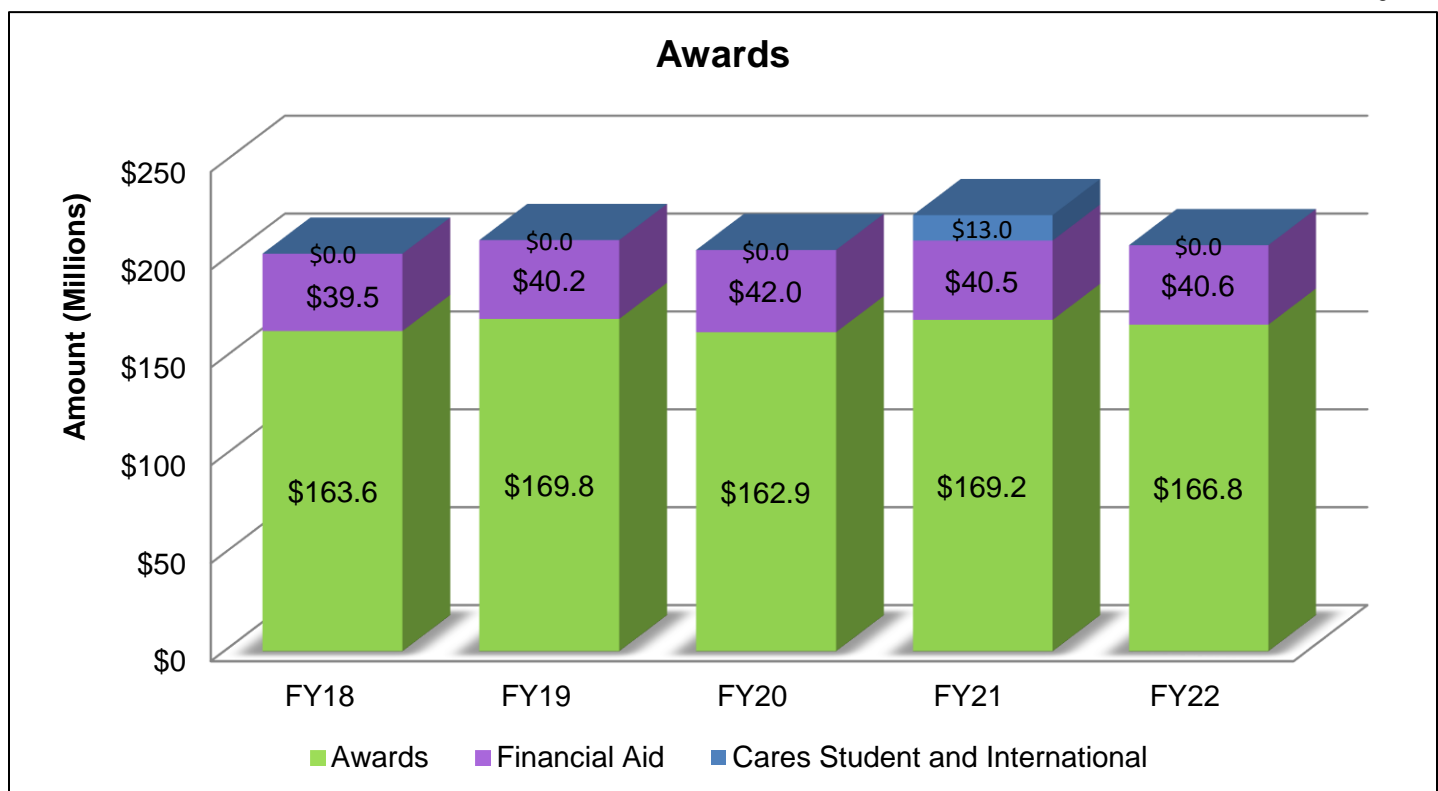

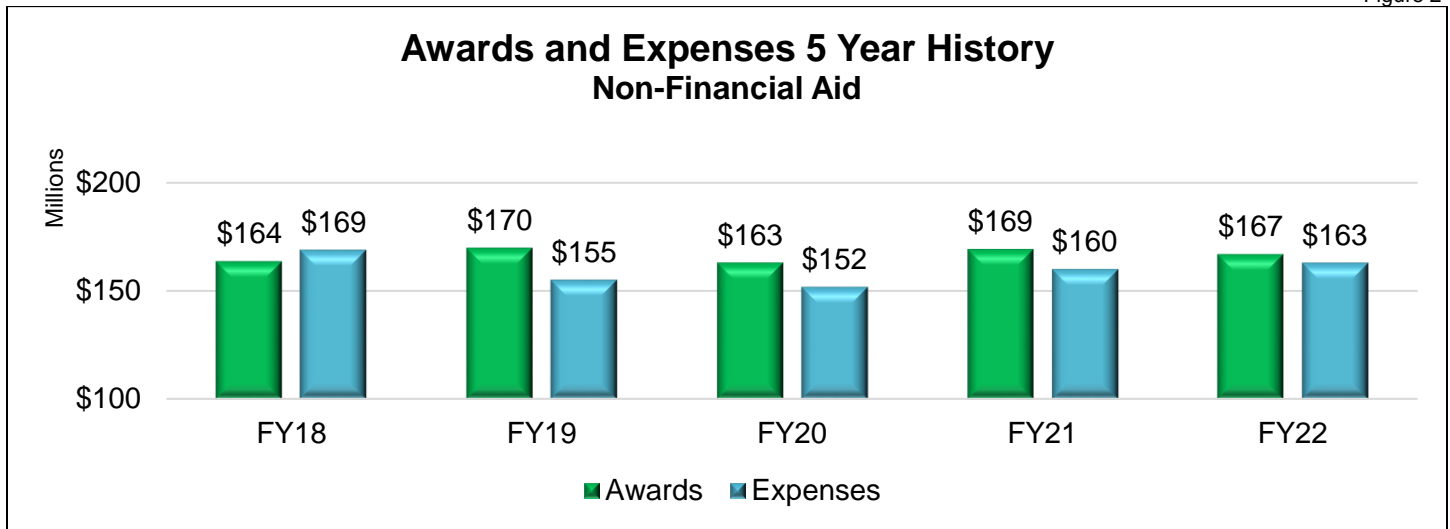
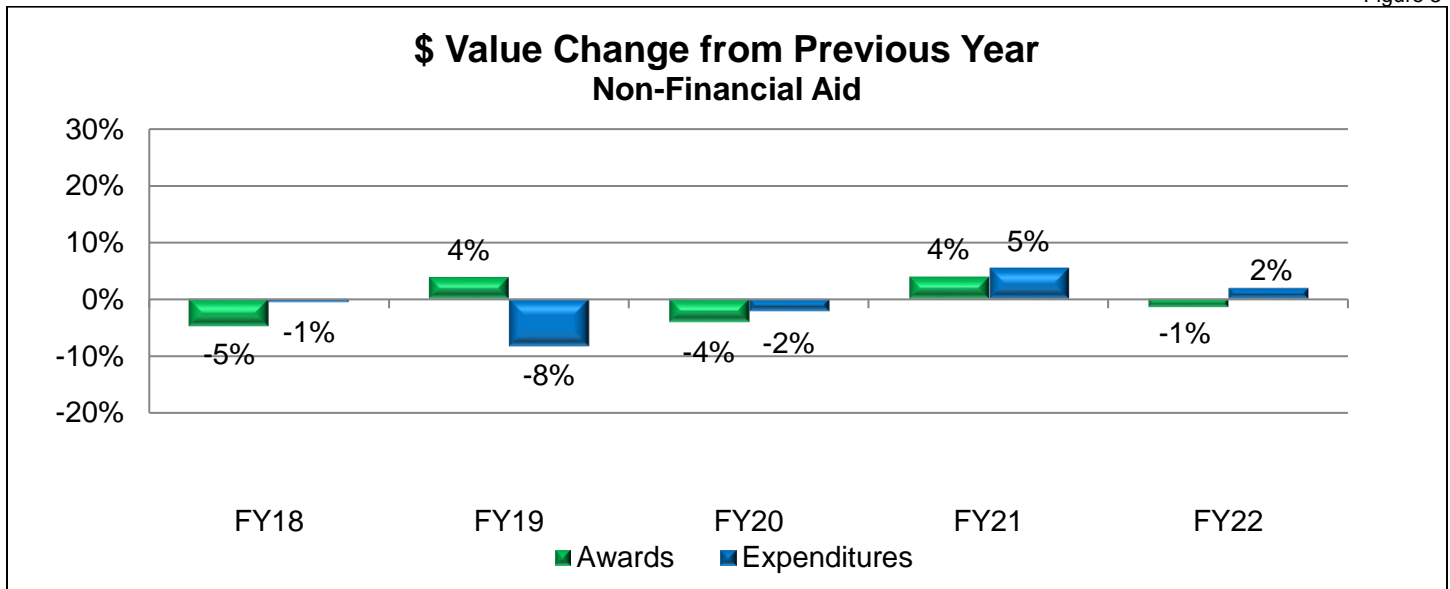


Figure 3 illustrates the relative changes in award and expenditure levels over the previous five years (Financial Aid excluded).

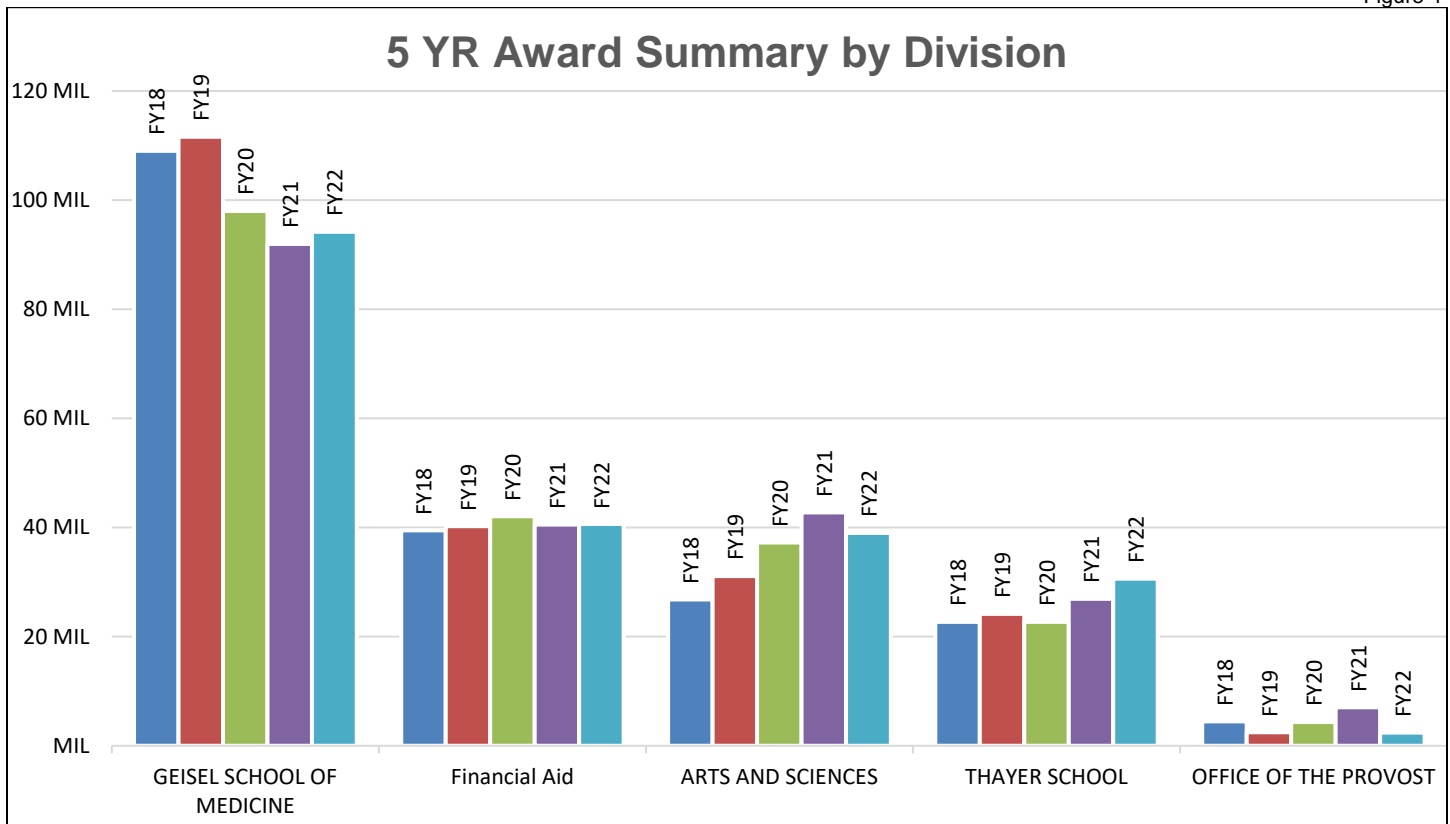
Awards by Division

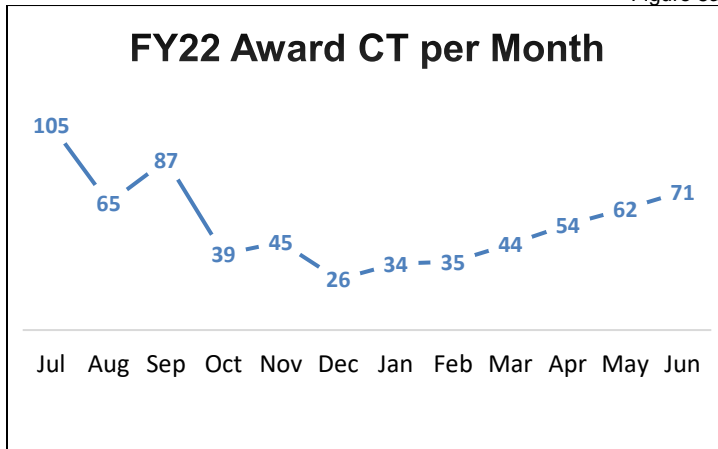
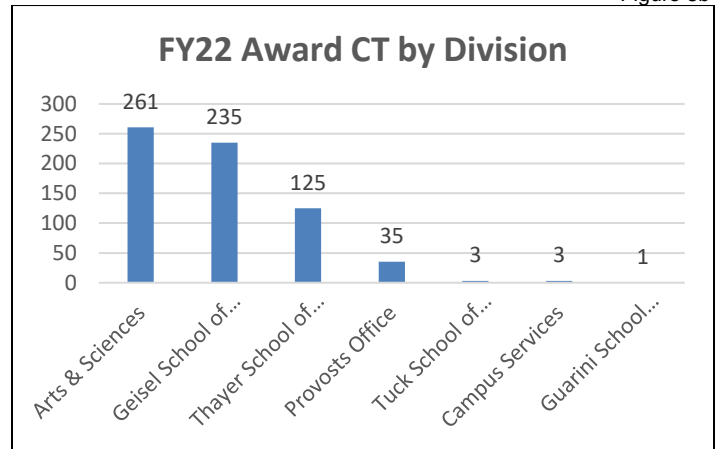

Award Funding Sources

As Figure 6 illustrates, Dartmouth College relies heavily upon government sponsored research. In FY 2022, government awards totaled \$130,062,078 (78% of total), compared to \$34,933,795 (21% of total) in private funding and \$1,205,818 (.7% of total) in foreign funding. Government awards decreased 3%, compared with FY21. Private awards increased by 3% over FY21 totals.

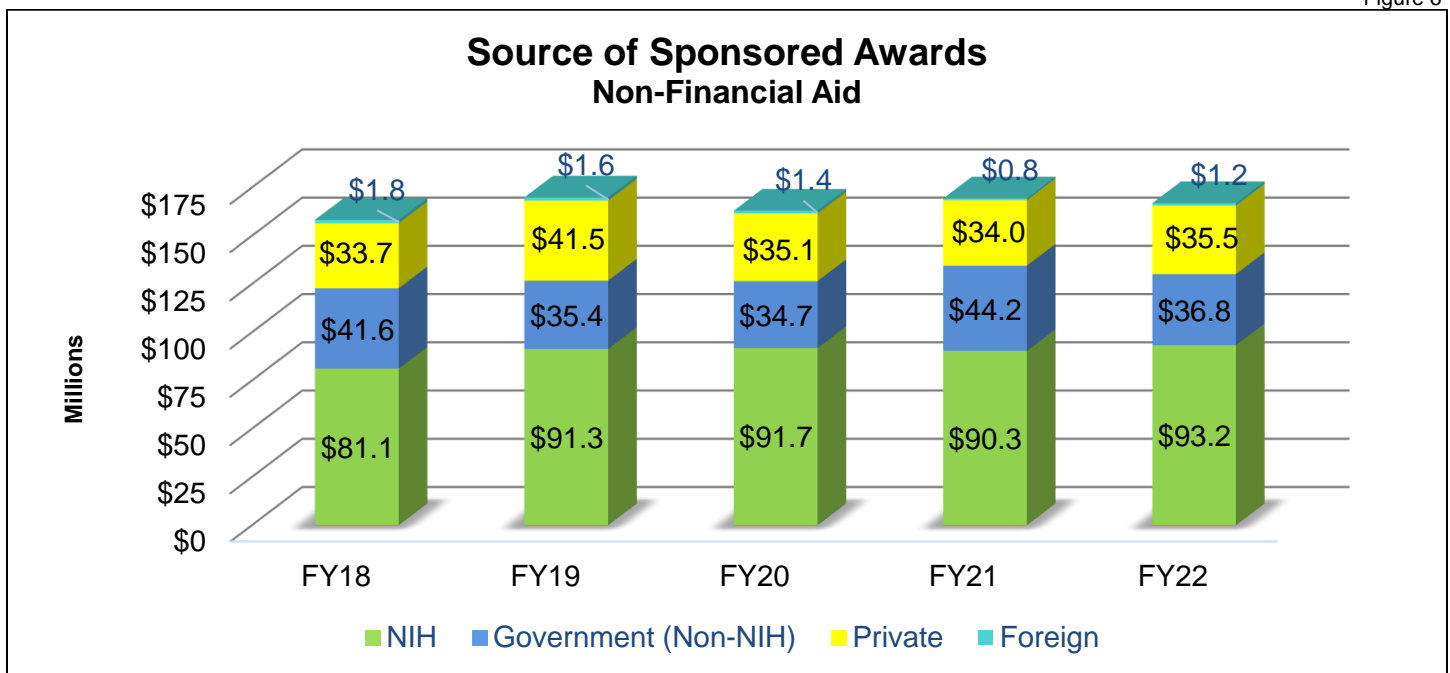

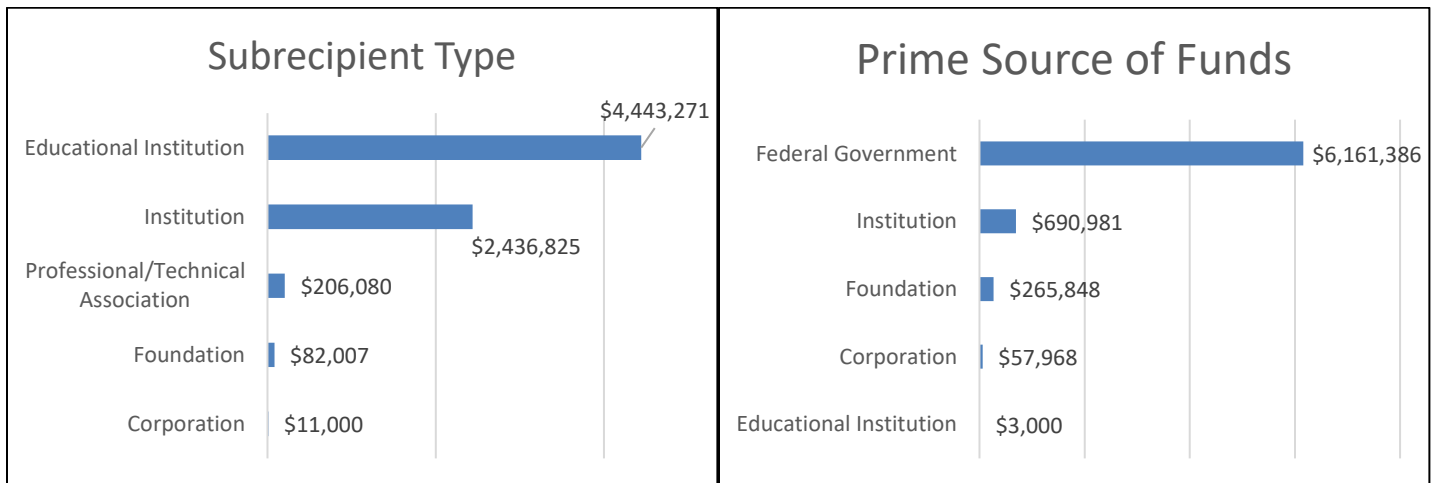

Proposals

Dartmouth College faculty and staff submitted 810 proposals totaling \$919,955,770 during fiscal year 2022. There was a 28% increase in the value of proposals submitted and a 12% decrease in the number of proposals submitted compared with FY21. One proposal (“The NASA Proposal”) had a value of 286,097,795, which exceeds the difference in proposal value between FY21 and FY22. The sponsor types that saw the smallest decreases in the number of proposal submissions were **Govt, Non-NIH** (5% decrease) and **NIH** (8% decrease). Submissions to **Foundations** decreased by 12% and submissions to corporations decreased by 17% each. Of the total value of submissions to an **Educational Institution**, 94% came from subawards. Proposed dollars are counted for the entirety of all proposals submitted in FY22, including dollars proposed for later years. As such, the proposed dollars cannot be compared directly with the awarded dollars, as awarded dollars only include dollars awarded for FY22.

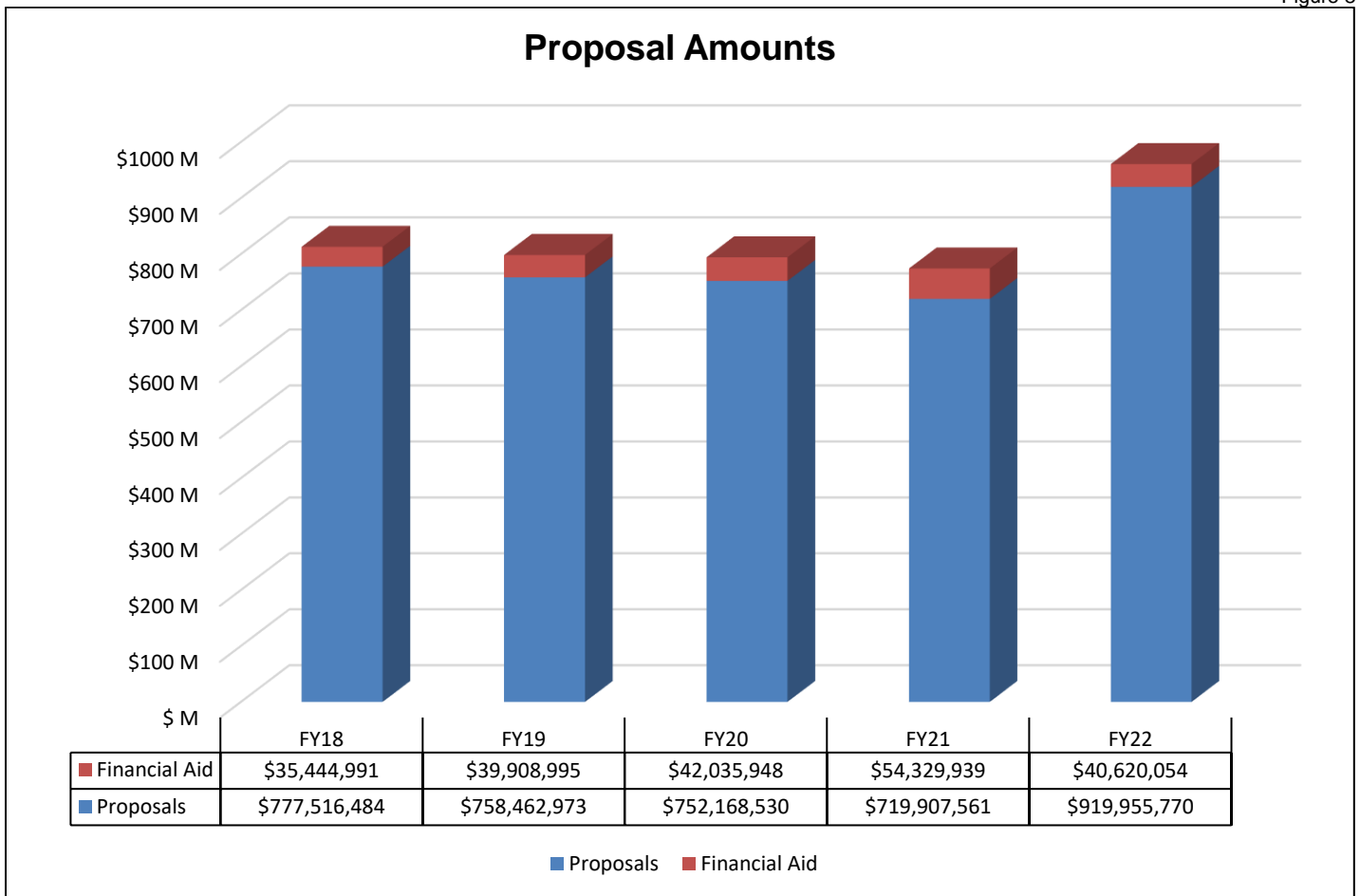
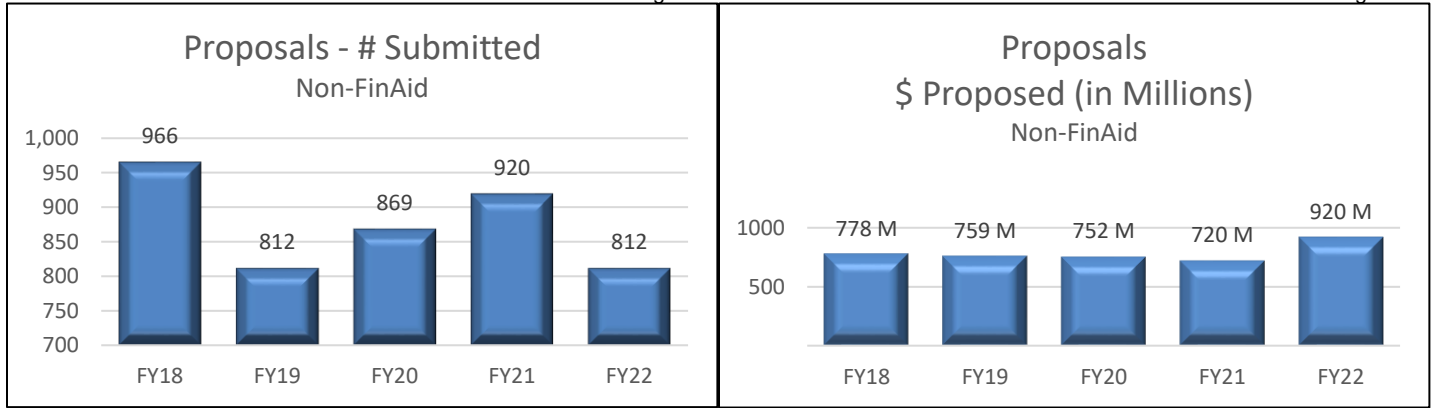

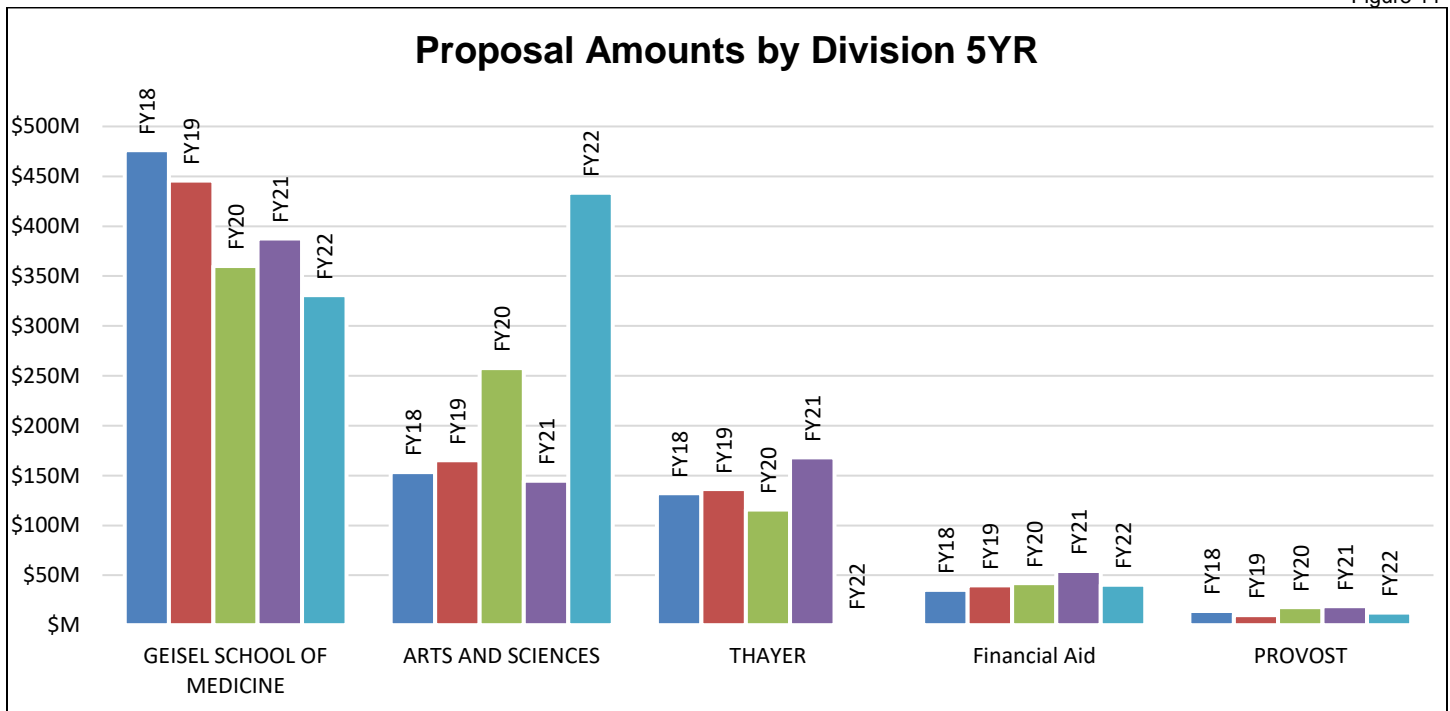
Proposals by Division

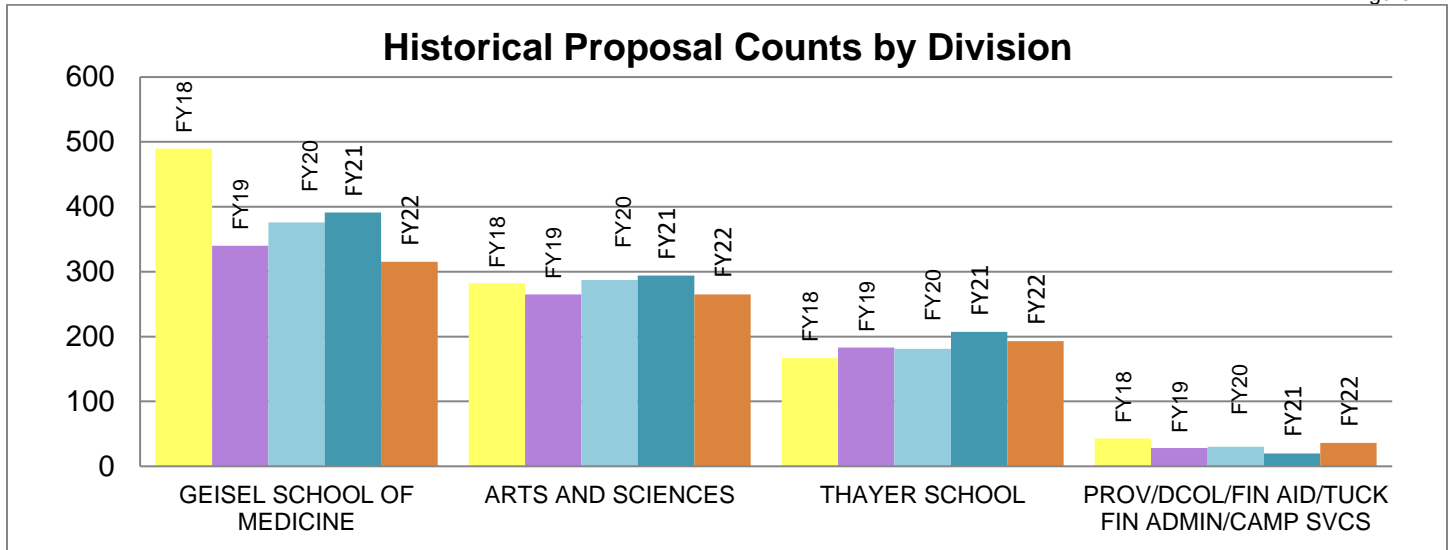

Agency Sponsored Expenses

Agency sponsored expenditures in fiscal year 2022 totaled \$221,484,785, an increase of 8% from FY2021. Excluding financial aid, direct expenses were \$117,243,915 (72%) and indirect expenses were \$45,675,110 (28%) in FY22.

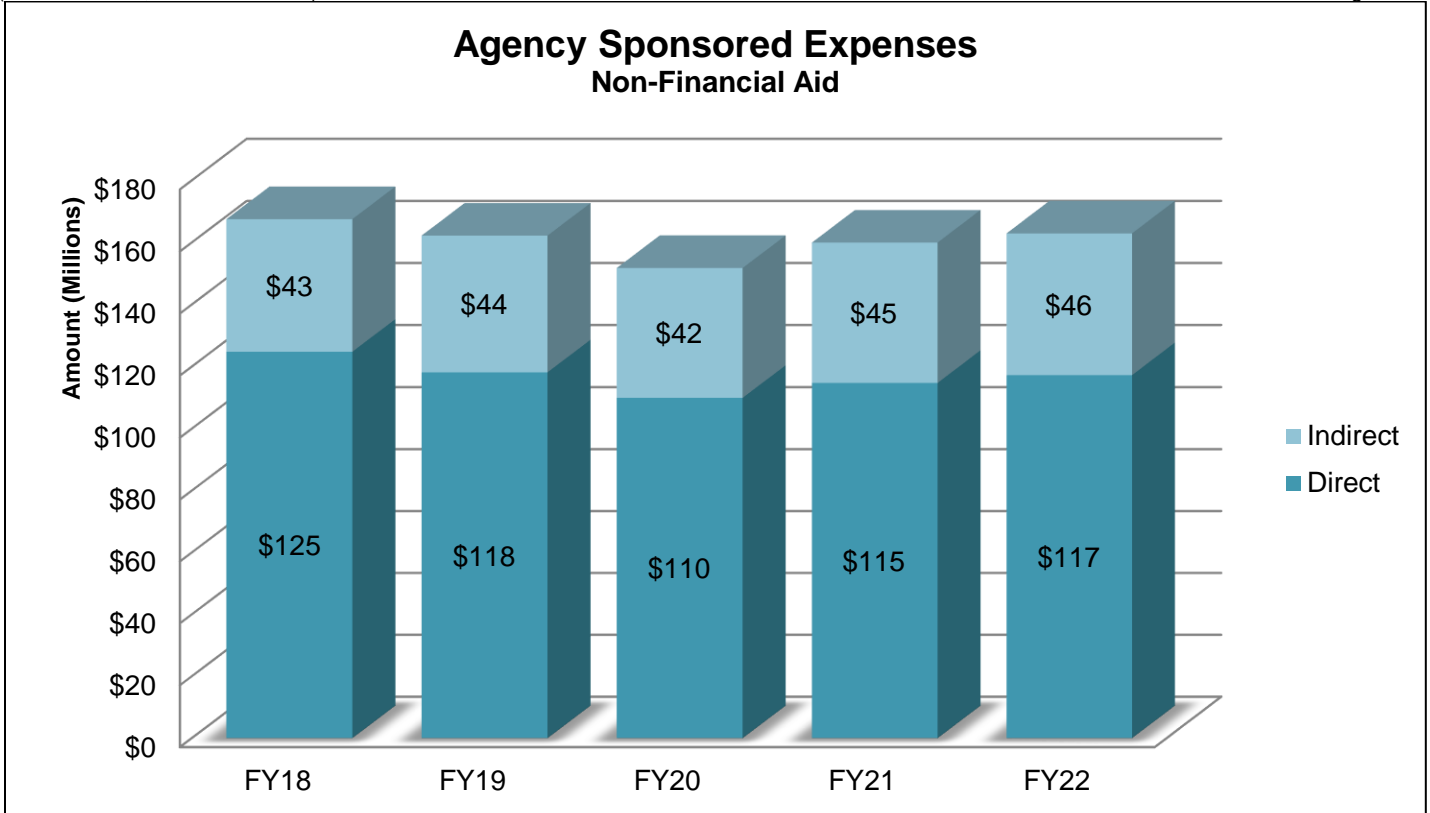

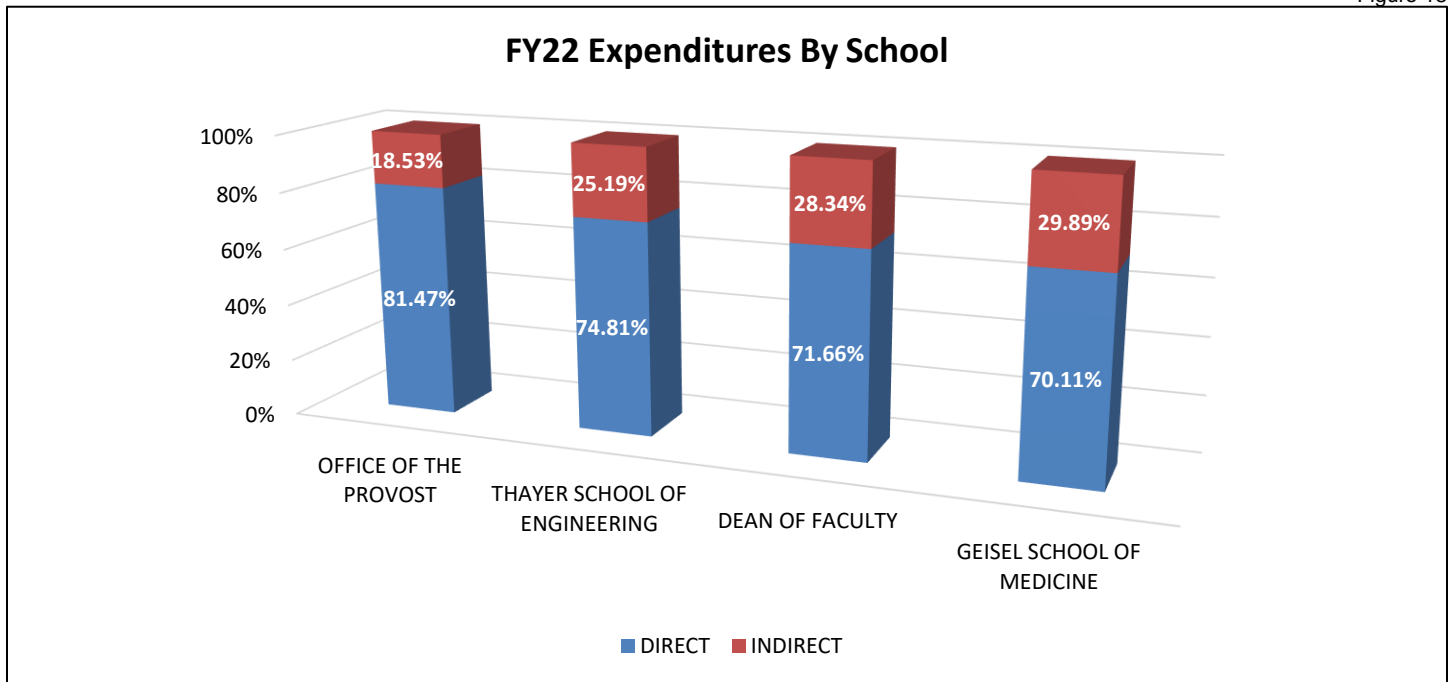

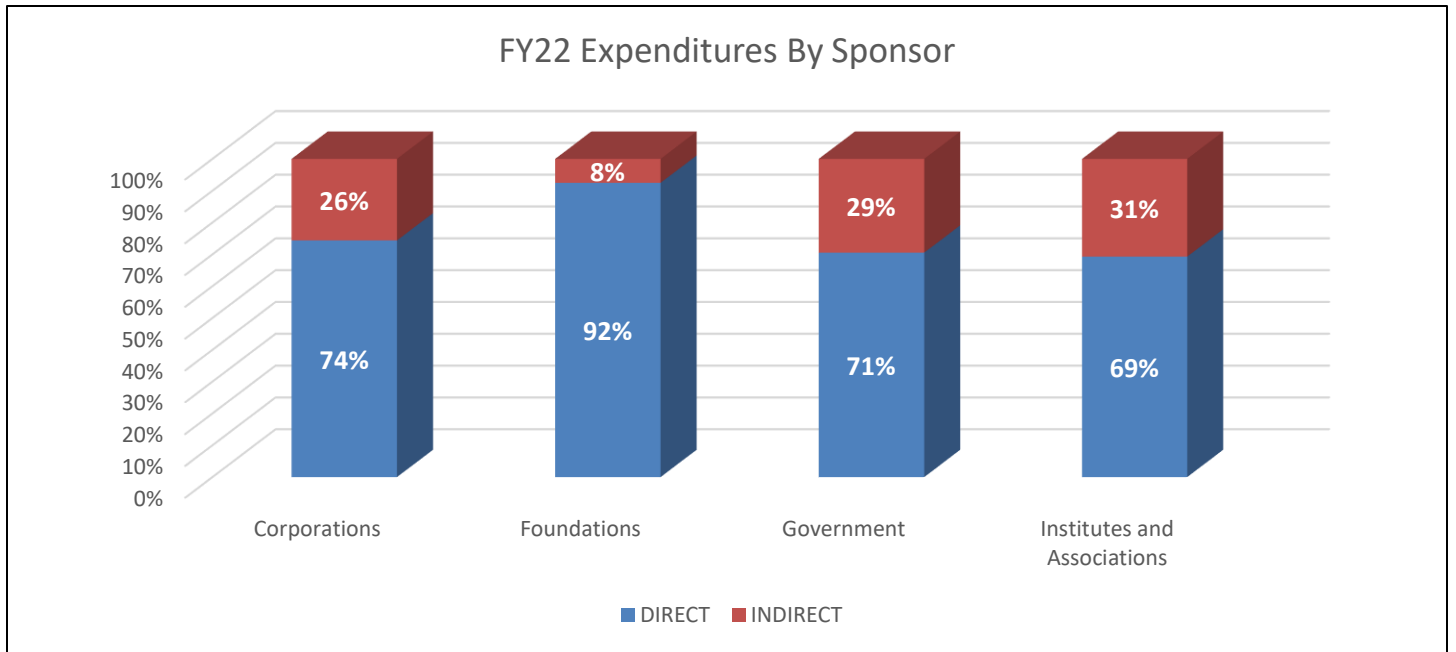
